NOTE ON ADOPTION OF PEREN GOVERNMENT COLLEGE

NAAC Accreditation is very important for Peren Government College otherwise it will stop getting funding from UGC and stand the chance of closing down

Effort has been made by the College authority for fulfilling the criteria laid down. However, there are still many areas where intervention is required. It is observed that targeted intervention is required at this stage by all stakeholders.

The District Planning and Development Board is the right platform for taking up development activities. In order to implement this, the DPDB may adopt the Peren Government College and the various line departments can tune some of their department plans and projects to the college.

For this purpose, a Core Committee may be constituted headed by the Deputy Commissioner, Peren -

Activities to be taken up by the various Departments

1. Improvement of road and construction of road signages for beautification
Improvement of road leading to the College and inside the Campus can be
taken up by the PWD (R&B) Department. Proper road signages can also be placed
as part of beautification.

The Department can also detail some work charge employees for constant clearances.

{ACTION : EE, PWD (R&B)}

2. Installation of power supply

Power supply within the Campus and along the roads can be taken up so street lighting can be installed.

(ACTION: EE, Power along with NRE Department if required)

3. Water supply X
Water supply line to the Campus along with water reservoir tanks and supply lines to the College Building, hostels and residential buildings should be properly connected.

The PHED Department or the Administrator, Peren Town Council can explore the provision of constructing Community Toilets under the Swacch Bharat Mission.

(ACTION: Administrator, Peren Town Council and EE,PHED)

4. Plantation of campus with decorative trees

The Forest Department can undertake plantation of decorative trees within the Campus as well as along the roadside.

(ACTION: Divisional Forest Officer)

5. Development of Horticulture Farm

The Campus has a Horticulture Farm which can be developed by the Agriculture and Allied Departments.

Agriculture Department can take up construction of water reservoir at the Horticulture Farm.

(ACTION: All Agriculture and Allied Departments)

6. Proposal for a Sub-Centre and setting up of a Medical Inspection (MI)
Room ×

The Medical Department can submit a proposal for setting up of a Sub - Centre at the Campus.

Meanwhile, a Medical Inspection (MI) Room can be set up by detailing some nurses along with adequate medicines to deal with medical emergency cases.

(ACTION : Chief Medical Officer)

7. Detailment of Police Security to the Campus

Peren Government College Campus is thinly populated at the moment In view of this, Police may be detailed for security of the Campus.

(ACTION: Superintendent of Police)

9. Solid Waste Management System

A proper Solid Waste Management system can be properly planned for the Campus by initiating segregation of wastes individual households/ hostels/ offices, construction of domestic compost pits and a proper mechanism for waste disposal.

The Peren Town Council can assist in the planning process.

(ACTION: Administrator, Peren Town Council and the Principal, Peren Government College)

10. Setting of Peren College Library

For NAAC Accreditation, an adequate library needed to be established consisting of about 6000 books. The following may be approached -

- A proposal may be submitted to the Assam Rifles through the Military Civic Action Programme.
- The Rural Development Department may be requested to assist. ii.
- A request may also be made to the Zeliang Officers' Association iii. Nagaland.

(ACTION: CO, Assam Rifles, Project Director, DRDA, President, Zeliang Officers' Association Nagaland)

11. Hostel for students
